

SCHOOL SUPPLIES
KINDERGARTEN
2011-2012

On the first day of school, all children need to bring the following items to share with the class. (You may also bring the supplies to Parent Orientation Night on August 17.)

Please DO NOT label any of the following items:

- 1 2-pocket folder (**no center strip with prongs**)
- 1 box of Kleenex tissues (110 count)
- 1 package of napkins (about 400 count)
- 2 packages of 5 oz. paper cups (90 or 100 count)
- 3 packages of “Wet Ones” or “Equate” (40 count) brand antibacterial wipes (These can be found at Walmart; we use them because they are safe for children to use.)

Please LABEL the following with a permanent marker

- 1 pair of gym shoes with Velcro or some type of fastener other than laces (to be left at school)
- 1 beach towel for quiet time
- 1 large backpack (must hold folder, towel, and lunchbox while zipped)
- 1 change of clothes in a Ziplock bag (pants, shirt, underwear, socks)

- 1 1-inch, white binder with the clear plastic cover (This will be your child’s portfolio, which will be returned to you at the end of 5th grade.)
