Annual Consent For Medical Care

This form must be signed and in our files before your student can attend school, participate in sports practices, pre-season camps, or participate in off campus field trips. There are no exceptions when it comes to the safety and well being of your child! These forms provide vital emergency contact information to the school and allow you to briefly address health concerns for your child. This form also gives permission for the school nurse to administer Ibuprofen, Acetaminophen, Pepto Bismol and Benadryl on an as needed basis should your child need this during a school day. *We will not dispense any medication without this signed consent.*



Annual School Physical

A school physical is an annual requirement for all students and is kept on file in the nurse's office.



Immunization Records

To comply with Colorado law, each student new to CSS must provide a complete immunization record before the first day of class. These records are kept in the nurse's office. Periodic updates of these records will be necessary.



Permission for Medication

All Divisions: No medications are allowed on campus, or on school trips, without the written permission of a physician. You must complete this form and return it to the school nurse with appropriate physician signatures before any medication – other than above-mentioned OTC medications - can be given. The form is valid for the academic school year. Do not send medications to school unless you have completed this form.

There are two circumstances in which you will need to complete this form:

- 1) if your child requires a daily mid-day medication, or
- 2) if your student requires any medication other than other than above-mentioned OTC medications on a school sponsored trip such as CS Fall Trip, MS Seminar or US Mountain Caravan.
