### INNOVATIVE KIDS AT THE COLORADO SPRINGS SCHOOL BUILD ROBOTS IN AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

**Colorado Springs, Colo.** – The Colorado Springs School (CSS) is currently engaging young minds in a dynamic afterschool enrichment program. First through fifth grade students signed-up for the New Horizons' ***Snap, Bot, Robotics***, a nine-week afterschool enrichment program. The program is being taught by Chris Petersen, a CSS technology teacher and Nori Madrigal, a CSS art teacher.



The students step into the future through the school's computer lab where it is a snap to create a robot. They work in teams to design and build real robots and learn to program them to perform loads of different operations. Students are programming their robots to respond automatically to the environment by adding touch sensors. While working in teams, the students are assigned the role of programmer, assembler or operator. The team works together to accomplish the mission. The program uses Lego Mindstorms Robotics for hours of hands-on fun and learning. Who knows, these kids may even figure out how to create a robot to do homework!
