Coach Vicki Vaughan leads the Kodiak basketball program where she has been a coach for 18 seasons, a teacher for 10, and now an Athletic Director. An Indiana Basketball Hall of Famer, Vaughan has been facilitating camps for over 28 years and takes pride in teaching basketball in a fun, safe, and healthy environment. Vaughan competed at Illinois State University where she helped lead her team to two Missouri Valley Conference championships. She coached collegiate basketball at USAFA, internationally in Ireland, and at Lincoln College in Illinois, where she was recently inducted into their Hall of Fame for her coaching success.

Coach Cathy Boswell

Coach Cathy Boswell joined the CSS coaching staff in 2018 as an assistant coach. Her background is impressive, which includes international experience as a player and coach for 30 years, along with an Olympic gold medal for Team USA in 1984. She and Vaughan were teammates at ISU where Boswell is only the second female basketball player to have her #44 jersey retired. Boswell enjoys player development and sharing her joy for the game of basketball with young people. She is fluent in five different languages, and she also coaches soccer for the Kodiaks.
